- Super interesting theories about politics, and I always loved the readings, even the ones for required reading summaries!

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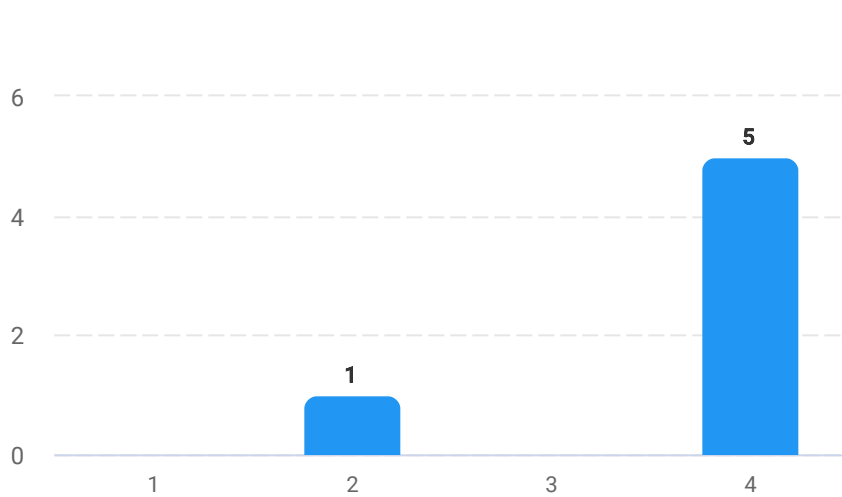

- Always spoke about these things, Dr really helped in explaining things through differing perspectives

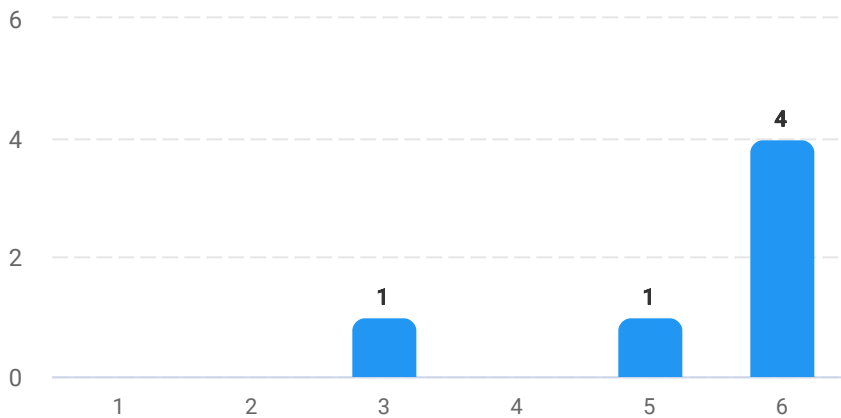
