Survey Overview : Course Section Results Aggregate



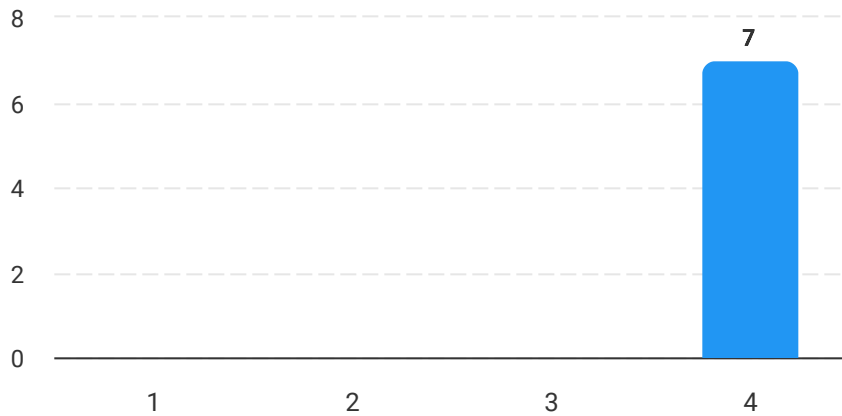

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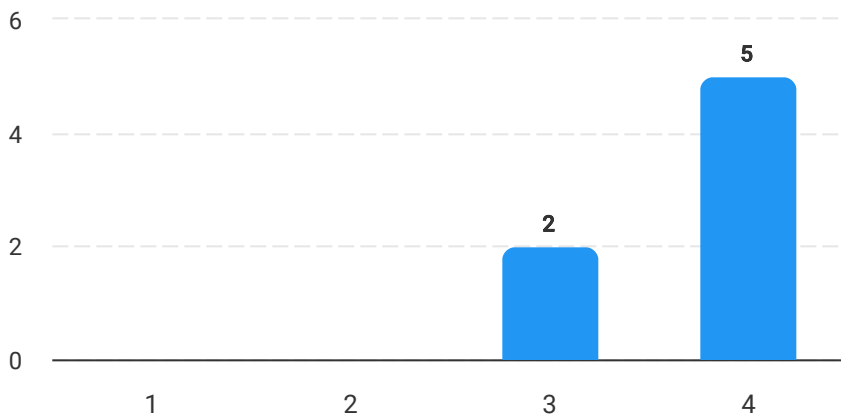

- Nick broke down complex things we learned in lecture and made sure we understood what it meant and how to apply it in R.

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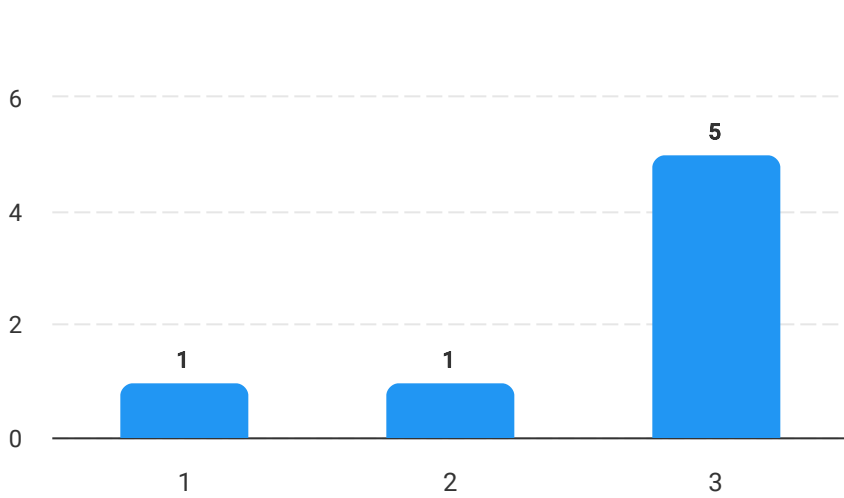

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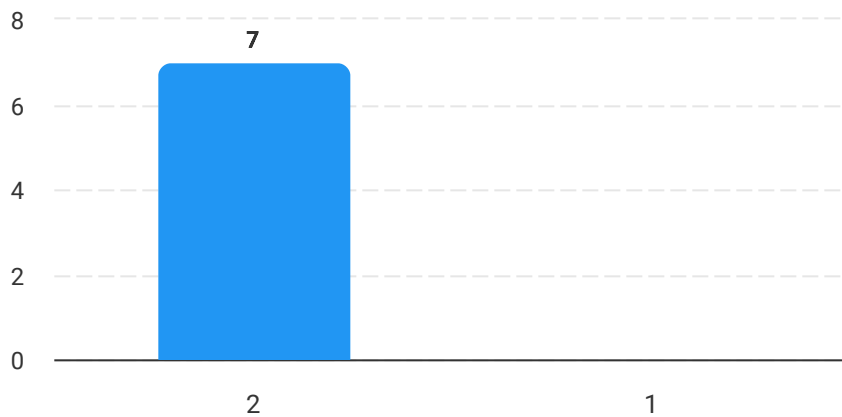

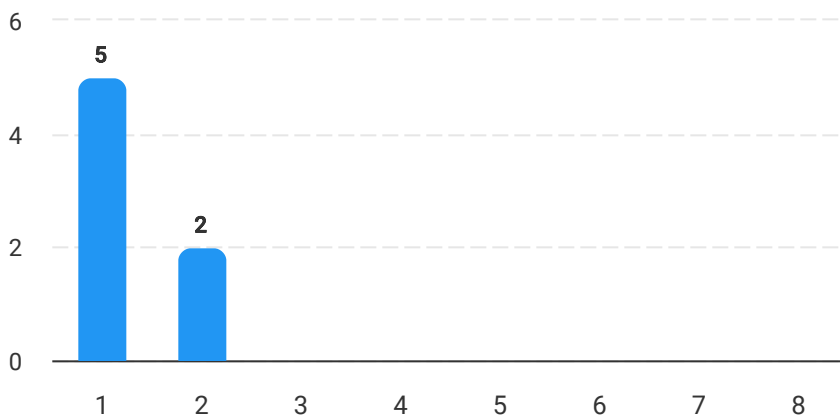
